

Documentary Revenues of Hungarian Forint-Krajczár Currency Period (1868-1898)

First Issues

The typograph "tailor-made" types 1868-69

Square-Center Denominations

1. the vignette lies above the frame
2. the with-lines run out below the frame

Know: with-lines meet on the frame

1. the vignette lies on the frame
2. the with-lines don't open
4. the with-lines meet under the frame

The first Hungarian manufactured vignette in official use (smaller size of frame)

1. vignette lower than the two lines
2. with-line cut to the corner

Types after the color change

4. the with-line meet under the frame
5. the with-line meet from corner to frame
6. the vignette meet under the frame

4. the with-line meet close to the frame
5. the with-line meet above the corner frame
7. the vignette meet above the frame

Circle-Center Denominations

The frame types of the coloured leaf with-lines

Left for left

1. the vignette lies on the frame
4. the with-lines meet on the frame above the corner

Below for left

4. the with-lines don't meet on the frame line
5. the with-lines meet above the corner frame

Types after the color change

2. the with-lines come apart on the frame
3. the vignette above the frame
4. the with-lines meet on the frame

2. the with-lines within the frame without open end
3. the vignette below the frame
4. the frame cuts off the with-line meeting
5. the with-line higher above the corner

2. the with-lines meet close to the frame
3. the frame cut to the vignette's bottom

* Learn research statement that the registration-stamp design must help be visible on the first phase of printing process. Otherwise the smaller, unprinted, or broken some of the coloured leaf with-line was necessary.

1868. Types only in Vienna.

Column type markings of 1 krajczár

The largest recorded 8 for multiple 30, unused

1868. Invents on two different types of papers

The existence of this kind of paper with insect holes along positions for the actual or more than one sheet with the same print area. Pair of inserts from the same "leaf" positions (30x70) are also visible.

1870. Insect on real estate registry document

November 6, 1877. Loan document for 100 forint and 10 forint interest. Paid registry fee 7 1/2 for. The 1 krajczár stamp is from 17th sheet position (p.32). It isn't an insect just placed upside down. The use of the 1 krajczár 3 years after the production is interesting. It illustrates the first issue's unproduced quantity. Therefore, the green 1 krajczár with Hungarian watermark is a rarity, see the stamp on the 1st frame at the overview of 1870 year.

1876. Large size 1868 advertisement. The box was 2 1/2 over the 1.200 cm². Paid tax with pair of 1 for documentary revenue issued of 2 for advertising stamp.

Denominations

The largest known one of 1 krajczár today

1881. issue, watermark "K" reconstruction

Selected from thousands of sheets to side this is the largest reconstruction sheet to estimate. Finding the watermark design and the perforations was an immense task in this regard.

Note the watermark edge the point between the 6th and 7th columns.

This is the 1st position of the "K" watermark.

Position identification markings

On left side stamps have similar markings like 1870 cardboard paper

Right side stamps

1881 issue, unused block of four with gum

1868. Mixed use of OPM* and Hungary based stamps

Dec 31, 1867. Receipt for payment of 70. Subsequently in 1868 correct to paid (20 to 20 forint) - 1 krajczár.

OPM* - Hungarian private abbreviation for Austrian Financial Administration in Hungary.

Column type markings of 3 krajczár

Only three columns can be identified with type distinctions (30-32). The "A" type from the position 75 in the bottom half is missing.

1878. block of four with "A" watermark

Transformed 70% reduced

July 9, 1877. Kéremkönyvi OSZ receipt that was attached to some form of communication with the Tax-revenue department.

Stamp Issues

Structure of the mother plate

1878. cardboard paper 257-26/67-68

Column type markings of 4 krajczár

1881 issue. Position placement 4 for stamp pair

4 for multiple use on real-estate registry document

Nov. 21, 1879. Szentgyörgyi, Office of Land Registry card. Document for registering a 38 ft value real-estate ownership transfer. The correct fee payment of 2 krajczár was much overpaid by 36 ft. Underpayment evident evidenced.

The actual stamps included 240 for issued 1873 and fed in issued in 1878 from two different sheets. See colour shade differences between the first and the following stamps.
