**Original research and final solution of a long time problematic differentiation for very similar but distinctly different two watermark**

1881. Neoplatonic paper with watermark "K"

1887. Flame paper with watermark "K"

1879 strip of three on paper paper

Good illustration for technical perforation in picture paper. Reason: the perforating comb (Dion Vernal) originally was designed for normal stamp paper, not for this extraordinary thin paper.

Receipt for 342 Ft. Rate for 200 to 200 Ft tax paid 63 krajczár. Early use of 50+10+10 stamps.

There are no identifying marks/hugs in the columns. Up to now only the shown position "twin marks" had been identified.

**1891. Flame paper and watermark positions**

Earlier years: ca. 0.275 mm heavy paper, when in water circles appear

From later years: less than 0.27 mm, lighter paper

30 watermark position

The difference between the 1st and 2nd position: the printing was done on different sides of paper. In case of the paper turned 180 degrees can also appear in two more positions.

Dec. 5, 1870. Receipt with use of 60 krajczár stamp

Receipt for 250 Ft. paid tax between 200 and 300 Ft. - 94 krajczár.

Same positions stamp pairs with "twin mark"

1881. p23-24 (or 73-74)

1881. p56-60 (or 58-59)

Same Flame "K" watermark on two separate issues (same position S)

**Kötelezvény.**

1000 forint

1884. 1870. Post. Promissory note, one year duration for 1,000 Ft at 6% interest rate. Documentary tax paid on amount of 1,000 Ft (1,000 - 60 Ft interest) at 0.0015 Ft per Ft. On receipt, dated a year later, receipt for tax paid off. Documentary tax paid 3 Ft 75 krajczár. Note: the 75 krajczár was left from old Vienna mode, while the 3 Ft stamp was from the 1870. First Hungarian production bright, yellowish green waxy or picture paper.

Column IV: 77

Block of four (F) p63-64/73-74

**Type markings of 60 krajczár**

Columns: I, II, III, IV, V

**FAKE.** Previously used, cancellation removed, re-gummed stamp.

1873. part 13.

Most likely for the purpose of deceiving collectors.

Nov. 20, 1890. Szentgyörgyi. Real estate transaction document for 560 forint. Paid correct tax rate for above 500 forint - 1 Ft 50 krajczár including the 60 stamp.

The plates of forint stamps have only 10 stamps. There are no "twin marks". Only recently were two positions identified.

**Type markings of 1 forint**

Columns: I, II, III, IV, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X

**1 forint value with the watermark for "krajczár" denominations**

1873. "K" sheet watermark

1888. Military Border Region 360 forint on document

Nov. 22, 1870. Copied. Against regulation document was written with no room left for the stamps. When recorded, stamps had to be placed on writings. Cancelled with pen and fluid ball stamp. Paid correct tax rate 24.50 krajczár.

Only two columns can be typed. The printing plate was worn-out and further study will be needed. Compared to the sample sheet some positions are identified (see right the examples).

**1890. Unusual, original gum**

1886. 2 forint-gum

Single use of 2 forint on document

Dec. 20, 1884. Post. Promissory note for 2,000 forints. Paid correct rate 2,000 to 4,000 forints - 2 forints. Documentary stamp with manufacturer's cancel, 1886 to type, white thin paper.

1873 to type, line part. 13 p88-89

The "V" watermark

1881 is line part. 115

"Silk" stamp use on Military Border Region document

Nov. 26, 1870. Receipt. Paid correct tax rate 21.50 krajczár. "twin" use of watermark indicated 1/3 the stamp.

Columns: I, II, III, IV, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X

1891. 1 forint, stamp pair: positions verified p47-48

April 14, 1896. Mortgage / Loan filing document by the Royal District Court at Mezőbény. Paid 1.76 kr on 900 Ft loan and interest - 6 Ft 93 kr 49 Ft.

The registration fee for over 100 Ft - 1 Ft 90 krajczár (in reverse stamp) were applied on the reverse.
